1966 has been a record year for the Shreve Kemorial Genealogy Room. The Room has become a "regional" deportment of the 4th Congressional District with each of the five parishes contributing to the support.

New quarters had to be found since the department had grown both in material and in patronage during the past few years. The year finds us in

the large basement room at the library.

107 new book titles have been added to the collections of material. Six new periodicals, almost 1900 rolls of microfilm as well as various kinds of unbound manuscript material. Four new microfilm cabinets had to be purchased to house the new minrofilm that was placed in the library by the Ark-la-Tex Genealogical Association. This microfilm is the court records of thirty-two parishes. While 1966 was a record year for the Genealogy Room, we hope that 1967 will be even better. We urge all of you to come to work in our new quarters.
