The first recorded meeting in Texas was held in Austin's Colony year the present town of Anderson, Grimes County, on January 20, 1834. This first meet: was held in the home of Daniel Parker, July 4, 1835.

The log church built here in December 1848 was the first church built. The present building is the fourth on this same site. There has been continuing worship on the site since 1833. Daniel Parker was the first pastor. He held this position from 1833 to 1844.

There is a small replica of the original church which was built in 1848. It is furnished with hewn log pews and furniture as was in the old church. This furniture is in miniature.

They were in the Republic of Texas in 1829, when a daughter, Nancy was born; and in Arkansas in 1831, when another daughter, Leanna (my great-great grandmother) was born. The family was on the 1840 census of Claiborn Parish, La., but by 1850, the wife of John is not listed on the census of Bienville Parish. Was John's middle initial "N", and if so, what did it stand for? I surely would like to hear from any descendants, or any purson who can tell me more about this family. The two daughters mentioned above, married into the Evans (Evens) and Johnston families.
