### A TRIBUTE TO A FINE MAN

Lt. Col. Floyd Richardson Farrar, Sr. (Ret), 71, who resided at 810 Wilkinson Street died at 6:15 Tuesday, September 17, 1968, at Doctors Hospital following a brief illness.

Col. Farrar, well-known in historical and genealogical circles, as well as in the insurance field, was a native of New Orleans and had resided in Shreveport for about twenty-two years.

He served in World War I in the Coast Artillery and in World War II in the field Artillery, Inspector General's Department of the Army. After moving to Shreveport he entered the insurance field and was an associate of what is now Fant, Chase and Kline, Inc. and the Jordan Agency.

Col. Farrar was a member of the Sons of the American Revolution and was one of those responsible for the reactivation of the local Galvez Chapter of the SAR, the oldest chapter in Louisiana. He was a member of the North Louisiana Historical Society, the Virginia Historical Society, the Virginia Historical Society, the Louisiana Historical and genealogical Society and a number of others. He was a member and treasurer of the Ark-La-Tex Genealogical Association, a member of the Shreveport Yacht Club and of the Church of the Holy Cross, Episcopal.
