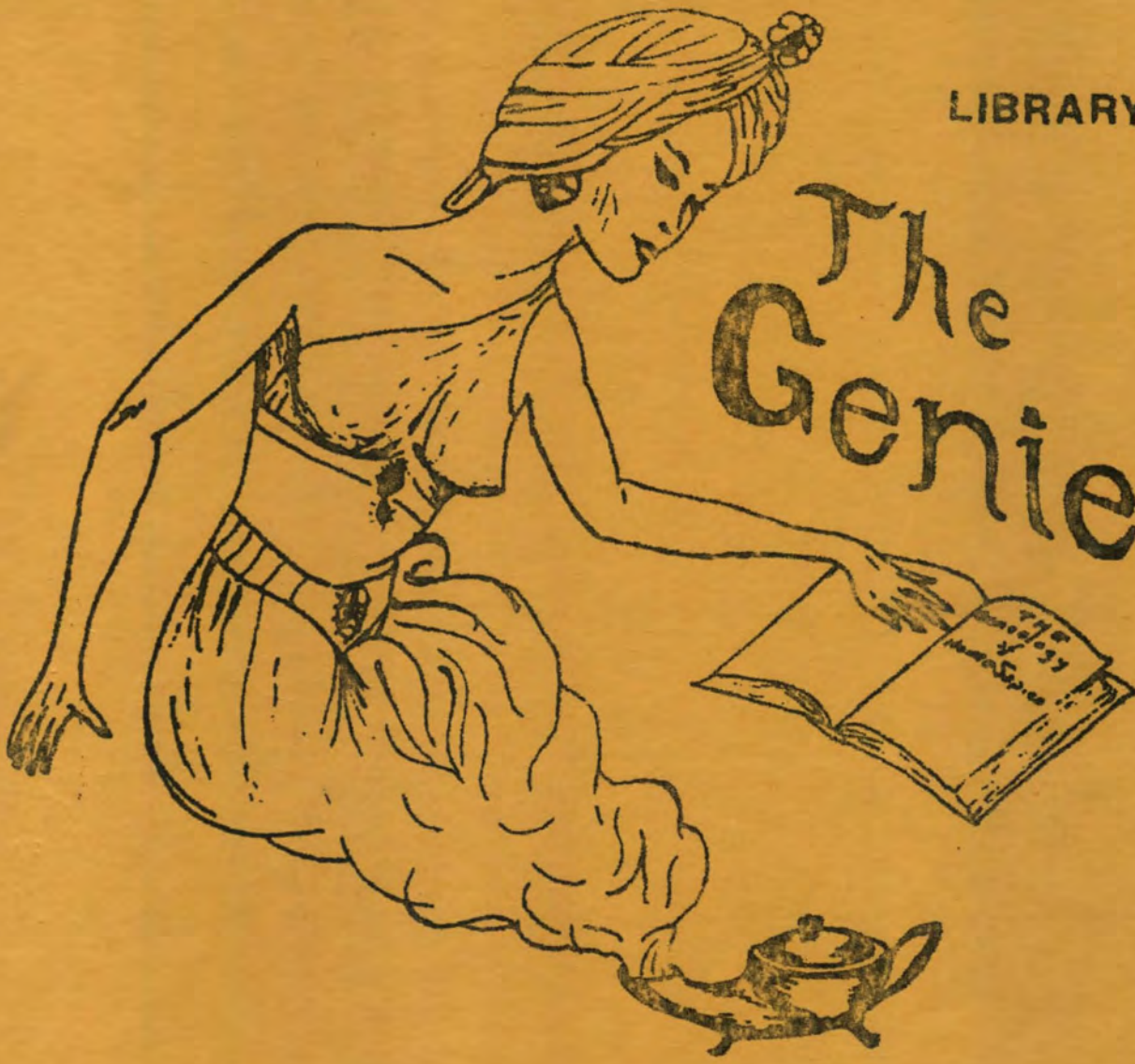

Member of the New England Historic Genealogical Society since 1923, member of its Committee on Heraldry, and former member of its Publications Committee. Member of the New York Genealogical and Biographical Society since 1940. Member of the Genealogical Society of Pennsylvania and the Genealogical Society of New Jersey since 1941. Member of the National Genealogical Society since 1942 and former editor of its Quarterly. Contributing editor of The American Genealogist since 1938.

Lecturer (annually since 1965) at the Genealogical Institute at Samford University, Birmingham, Alabama; lecturer at the World Conference on Records, Salt Lake City, 1969; lecturer at the Harvard University Summer School Seminar on New England Family History, 1976 and 1977; and lecturer at the Genealogical Seminar in Cleveland, Ohio, 1976.

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- HOW "THE GENIE" CAME TO BE -

The Ark-La-Tex Genealogical Association was organized in 1955 with President Lester White, Secretary Eleanor Fletcher and sixteen members.

Fern Ainsworth was president in 1958 and for a short time a Newsletter was published.

In July 1961 thru 1962 with Ernest Neil Gray as Editor, the organization published Vol. 1 - No. 1, 2 & 3 of "Ancestors in Review". Records were copied and submitted by members and volunteer searchers, under the direction of Louise Barnett, who was president for six years.

Ben Achee also served a term as president.

R.T. Colquette was elected president in 1967 with Marjorie McGraw (later Mrs. Wright) Genealogical Librarian of Shreve Memorial Library as Editor of the Newsletter.

A contest was conducted for a suitable name for the publication. Josephine Miller a member was the winner, with her entry "THE GENIE". Mrs. Wright served as Reporter, Editor and Publisher of The Genie for three years.

Ennis M. Tipton was president from 1969-1972. Emma Tipton was Editor for five years.

T.V. Holmes Jr. was president in 1973, M.L. "Pete" Nance was elected president in 1974, Gordon Wallace Smith as Editor of The Genie.

Veda Thornhill was elected president in 1977 to serve a term of two years, with John A. Manry, Editor of The Genie and Lewis Thornhill, Assistant Editor.

We are proud of our "Genie" and wish to thank everyone who has contributed to making it a success.

"The Colquitt Methodist Church"

The Colquitt Methodist Church is well over 100 years old. Its recorded history goes back to 1852, but from the memory of the oldest members, it has been established that there was a church there several years prior to that date. Among the pioneer members were the following families: The Wilsons, the Tigners, the Palmers, the Monks, the Greers, the Christians, the Adams, and the Spears.

The church had as its beginning a two room log building. One room was used as a church and the other was the Community School house. On May 31, 1880, this log building was destroyed by fire, and the church services were held in the Masonic Lodge Hall until a new church was completed in 1886. This church remains as the main auditorium of the church today.

In 1912 the church building was blown from its foundation by a tornado. After this was repaired, there were no other changes made until the years 1936-1937 when the building underwent a few changes and repairs, under the leadership of Rev. B. H. Andrews, who was then pastor.

In 1950, during the pastorate of Rev. W. D. Milton, three Sunday School rooms and a Fellowship Hall were added along with other general repairs.

In 1954, the last change in the building was made by the addition of two rest rooms and a ladies' lounge. This was done during the pastorate of the present pastor, Rev. Jack Midyett.

Since Colquitt has always been on the Haynesville charge, the Forty-one pastors who have served the Haynesville church have also served the Colquitt congregation.

## NATCHITOCHEES PARISH LOUISIANA NOTES

By Fern Ainsworth

The name BARNHILL is of Scots origin, however many of them were Scots-Irish or Scots who went into Northern Ireland to live. The original name in Normandy, France was deBerneval, and documented records as far back as 1143 are available concerning this family.

The Coat of Arms is an ancient one; a gold cross on red background and other details give proof of their participation in the Crusades.

The family is traced to Basle, Switzerland from France, back to France, then to Scotland. One of their characteristics is that of stubbornness and independence. They will not tolerate interference especially in their families, religion or country. I quote from Scott's "LAY OF THE LAST MINSTREL" which will illustrate:

"On Minto's Crags the moonbeams glint  
where Barnhill hewed his bed of flint  
who flung his outlawed limbs to rest  
where falcons hang their giddy nest."

This Barnhill became an outlaw rather than have his ruler dictate to which church he should belong.

From Scotland many of the Barnhills went into Ulster or Northern Ireland, thus becoming Scots-Irish, and from there to America.

In the extensive research for the BARNHILL, BARNWELL, BARNEHILL, BARNHELL, BARNHALL, BRAMWELL, etc., we find another family closely associated; the Elliots. The name is derived from de Ayelot, and is traced from France into Basle, Switzerland, back to France, to Scotland, into Northern Ireland and on to America.

They, along with the Barnhills and other Scot and Scots-Irish families, came into Pennsylvania or Delaware to North Carolina, South Carolina, Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia, Mississippi, Louisiana, Arkansas and Texas and every other state in the Union. They are mentioned in almost the same areas; both time and geographical, as the Barnhills. There are living in North Louisiana area at this time at least 3 ELLIOTT BARNHILLS.

In the book "THE ELLIOTTS OF MINTO", Barnhill is mentioned as being in their battles with the authorities of the land in the 17th century. There is also the Barnhills of Stobs. Both of these areas are in Lowland Scotland.

These families, all followers of Jean Chauvin or Chauvan (John Calvin) born 1509 in Picardy, France, which simply means they were Presbyterians.

This first note on the Barnhill Family will discuss 2 Barnhill immigrants without taking their descendants down to the present generation, but in the next note in October, I will start with one immigrant and bring his family down to the present generation. This is the family which settled in Natchitoches Parish, Louisiana.

NATCHITOCHE PARISH NOTES CONT'D.

The first Barnhill of which we have record is that of David, who, according to family tradition, came to the colonies from Scotland ca 1731. They were Lowland Scot Cameronian Presbyterians and bitter opponents of the Stewarts. The founder of this Scottish religious sect of Cameronians, which later formed the nucleus of the regiment of this name in the British Army, was Richard Cameron, born circa 1648 in Falkland Fife on the main road from Edinburgh to Dundee.

The village of Barnhill is of Monifieth Parish, Forfarshire (Angus) situated on the main line from Dundee to Forfar east of Dundee.

David Barnhill born circa 1695 in Scotland was in Delaware probably by 1731. He is mentioned in the will of Elinor Patton executed in 1732 and names heirs; sons Robert, Thomas and daughter Sarah Fleming, granddaughter Mary Fleming; son-in-law John Fleming. Witnesses: Robert Lecky, Robert Fleming and David Barnhill. The will was probated 11 Dec. 1738. (Arch. Vol A39, Page 135 Reg. of Wills Liber 1, Folio 2 Kent County, Delaware.

In the Proprietors Grants for Kent County, Del., located at the Historical Society of Delaware, are 2 warrants and 2 surveys for David Barnhill and there are no other entries under this surname. The first for 100 acres is in the forest on Black Swamp Branch, Murderkill Hundred and is dated 24 July 1734. The Hundreds in Delaware were political subdivisions of the counties comparable to townships in most other states.

David Barnhill married Margaret Fleming, daughter of Robert, (see will of Robert Fleming dated 20 April 1751, who mentions as heir Margaret Barnhill, daughter of David Barnhill). This family moved to Pitt County, N. C. by 1762 and their records are very well documented.

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ROBERT Barnhill and his first wife left Northern Ireland (Ulster) in the mid 1700's landing at New Castle, Delaware, then settled in Chester County, Pennsylvania. In June 1776, Robert moved to Orange (now Alamance) County, North Carolina, where in 1778 he entered a claim on Quaker Creek, a branch on the Haw River. His will, probated August 1797, names his second wife Margaret, and sons James and John. James (2) born in 1756 in North Ireland, moved with his parents to Orange County, North Carolina and served in Gen. Rutherford's Regiment of Infantry in the Rev. War. He changed the spelling of his surname to Barnwell. He married Susan Harper in 1788 and died in 1825 leaving the following children:

1. Robert born in 1789, moved to Illinois
2. Elizabeth born in 1791, died young
3. Catherine born in 1794, married 1817 Anderson King, and died 1860/70 Red River County, Texas.
4. John born in 1797
5. William Born in 1800
6. Susan born 1802, died 1860/70 Alamance County, N. C.
7. Nancy born 1804 married 1825 Thomas Vincent, died Lamar County, Texas
8. James born 1807 died ca 1865 Alamance Co. N. C.
9. Eleanor born 1809 died 1886 Alamance Co. N. C., m Anderson Hall
10. Elisa born 1812 died 1817

### INDEX TO NATURALIZATION RECORDS, CHESTER DISTRICT, SOUTH CAROLINA

In 1682 the Lord Proprietors of the South Carolina Colony established three counties to be laid out: Berkeley, Craven, and Colleton, and later Granville. In 1769 the Province divided into seven judicial districts. Following the American Revolution, counties were laid out in each district. In 1800 each of the existing counties became the jurisdiction of a district court and henceforth were known as districts. Before the Revolutionary War, inhabitants were known as citizens of the colony, and in 1784 conferred the rights of citizenship on aliens, but in 1786 repealed it. In 1787 the U.S. Constitution, Article I, Section 8 gave Congress the power to establish a uniform rule for naturalizing aliens.

It also includes the names and locations of all the land offices within the Alabama, Arkansas and the Florida areas.

The book makes clear that the Chicano is a human being, and an American whose heritage came from the Iberian Peninsula and the American Indian, rather than the northern European areas.

This book is a fascinating story of a man (Jose Rafa), who begins a search and finds in that search; destiny, fulfillment and sorrow and joy.

Candelaria has probed a question many readers should investigate before dashing off to dig up their "roots". And although this book focuses on one American man trying to shed the negative label of one race in order to don the positive cloak of another, it applies to each human being. And that, in any era, is all an artist can hope to do --- touch everyone of our hearts.

It is likely that many of the early settlers in what is now Cabell, Nicholas, Logan, Fayette, Jackson, Braxton, Boone, Gilmer, Putnam, Calhoun, Reane, Clar and Lincoln Counties, West Virginia were included in the Personal Property list compiled by John Wilson in 1806.

The second list in this volume was compiled in 1809, after Cabell County was cut off from Kanawha. The names from both lists reflect German, English, Scots and Irish origins, with a mixture of French and Welsh.

When an estate was filed for probate, it was assigned a number. In about 1935 all of the cases completed were assigned a NEW number and classified as 'disposed' cases. To locate the original records, the NEW numbers must be used.

The njmbers in this index are the NEW numbers that were assigned to these cases in the 1930's.

The probate cases of Dallas County, Texas also include guardianship cases and lunacy cases.

These first 3,100 probate cases have been microfilmed by members of the Dallas Genealogical Society, totalling 35 reels of film.

Some of the names found in this index are: Alford, Ardrey, Attlebury, Bast, Beeman, Boyd, Caldwell, Coombes, Floyd, Graves, and Gray.

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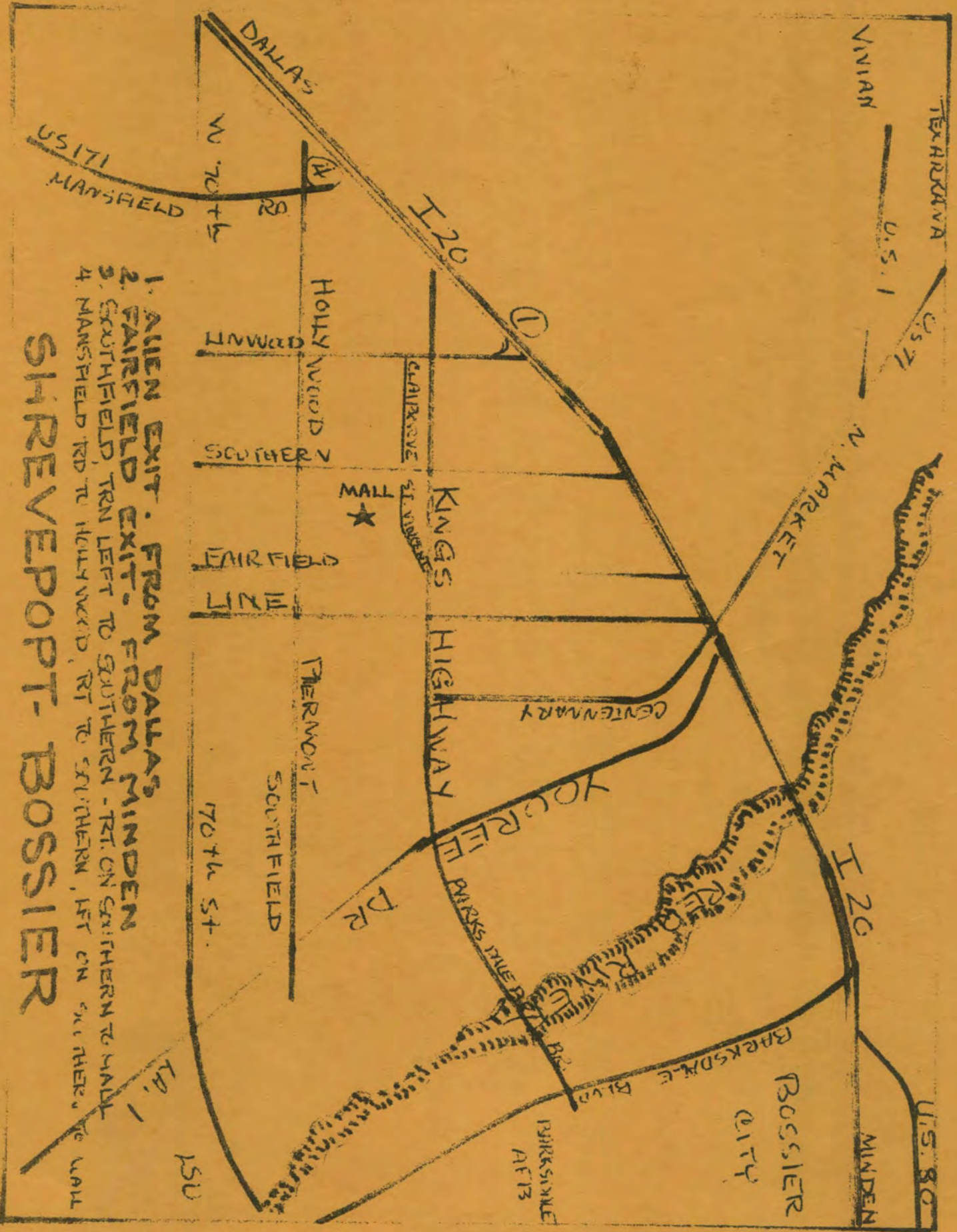
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
