MINUTES OF MR. LEBANON BAPTIST CHURCH

SUBMITTED BY MR. WARREN L. BAKER, JR.

We are very fortunate to have a member of our genealogical organization who has a copy of the minutes of this old Baptist Church, located in 1837, when they came to Louisiana, in Claiborne Parish, but when Bienville, Parish was taken from Claiborne Parish in 1848, the area of Mt, Lebanon fell into the area now comprising Bienville.

In 1837 a colony of emigrants removed from Edgefield District, South Carolina to Claiborne Parish, Louisiana, and were recognized at that time as a Baptist Church by a presbytery consisting of John Mill and Henry Adams. The organization of the Baptist State Convention was a forward movement of great importance. An informal meeting was held at Mt. Lebanon in 1847, of which no minutes were kept, but in December 1848 a number of brethren met at Mr. Lebanon for deliberation and a meeting was organized by calling Elder James Scarborough to the chair, and appointing W. W. Crawfords as secretary. Mr. Warren L. Baker, Jr. of Fairview Heights, Illinois has offered to send this data for publication to THE GENIE, and we surely appreciate his efforts in this undertaking.

On March 17, 1854 Reuben Drake deeded to the Mt. Lebanon Church $6 \frac{1}{4}$ acres of land.

On Dec. 13, 1855 Martin W. Key deeded approximately $\frac{1}{3}$ of an acre of land to the church.

The church acquired land from Jasper Gibbs on April 8, 1856. Due to the manner in which this land is described, it would be necessary for a survey to be made to determine the acreage.

On July 20, 1857 the church sold to J. R. Pitman 80 acres of land acquired from Reuben Drake and reserved therefrom six acres of land for used as a graveyard.

On Sept. 1 1888, W.M. Washburn made a survey of the Church lot and measured the acreage as $8 \frac{1}{4}$ (eight and $\frac{14}{100}$ acres.

Without a survey being made of the land, we do not believe that an accurate figure for the number of acres can be arrived at.

Several years ago I decided to trace my Beeman family, and published a book on the Beeman Family of Mississippi and North Carolina.

Then my wife asked me to trace her Wells and Houston lines. I had some good luck on her Wells, and got back to Zorababel Wells, born 1750 in Virginia, but on the Houston line it was another story, and I had to learn that the Houstons from Georgia pronounced the name House-Ton, while the others pronounce the name like you pronounce Houston, Texas.

In my Houston search I found a horse thief in Georgia, a poacher in Virginia, and a Baptist preacher on the Natchez Trace.

I finally learned there was one family of Houstons that knew something about my wife's Great Grandfather, Joseph Houston of Collinsville, Lauderdale Co., Miss. So I wrote them but received no reply. Then I asked a correspondent of Meridian, Mississippi, to go out there and interview this family, and a copy of that person's letter to me follows, and the Joseph Houston that the letter is about is my wife's Great Grandfather.

Enclosed is a bit of Houston information that I got from Mr. Jesse D. Houston at Collinsville, an elderly man in his 80's. (now deceased) (His son, Dan Houston Ins. Agcy., Collinsville, Miss. 39325)

JOE HOUSTON, Jesse D. Houston's grandfather, was brought to the Collinsville area at the age of twelve by Gen. Sam Houston and left with a farmer. Gen. Houston told the man to keep him a year and teach him what he needed to know. He bought the boy a horse

and saddle and left. During the time that he was gone, Mr. Houston did not know how long, he kept in touch with the boy and man. Later Gen. Houston came back and bought a large tract of land, several thousand acres, from the M & O Railroad and gave it to the lad. Years later the same Joe Houston began selling small plots of a hundred or so acres until almost all of the huge tract got into the hands of other settlers. He kept a sizable place for himself and his own heirs.

Joe Houston married Elmira Hamrick - date unknown - and had the following children:

Three infants died - this is not the order in which these children were born, but the easiest way that Mr. Houston could recall them. Lum and John O. were the first and second children.

An attempt was made a few years ago to trace the family back to Ireland and Mr. Houston contributed to the project. He has not had a report on it for quite a long time and wonders what happened.

These were the grandparents of the Mr. Houston who gave me the information. He is descended from Joseph L. through his son Joe.

Joseph Wells has descendants in Meridian according to Mr. Houston. There are several Wells in the telephone directory; I have just tried to call some of them and got no answers. Evidently they are at work. I shall try again at night and see what luck I have.

It will be next week or later before I can get to the library to check the late 1800 census records. My husband will have surgery soon and I will be with him for a few days.

Hope this bit of data will be a help to you. I shall keep a lookout for anything further on the names that I may run into.

Then later I contacted a Houston descendant in Texas and you will see by that letter following that they could get no information from the family.

Hi-

Your letter came today and is the first correspondence that I have received on the HOUSTON name. Was so glad to hear from you.

Family traditions is: "You'll never be able to trace the HOUSTONS. Joseph came from Tennessee with his mother as a small boy. They came in a wagon with a group."

Tex (my husband) and I think that some where some descendants know his parentage. Tex's grandfather was Thomas Jefferson M.D., he got his medical schooling at the Tennessee Medical School in Memphis, he is supposed to have had some post graduate work at New York Polytechnic. Evidently he was not at all interested in his ancestors, he didn't even know the right birthplaces of his grandparents when he filled out the death certificates. He started practicing medicine in 1889 in Heidelberg, Mississippi, moving later to Meridian, MS. where he died.

Tex got names of about 17 of Joseph & Almira's children from an old man one time when he went to Collinsville looking for the cemetery where they are buried. At the time we didn't know about Hamrick's. Tex's aunt said that there were more than 17, more like 20. We use Texas State Library and Archives (about 40 miles from here), they have a book of tombstone inscriptions so the Hamrick's are copied from the book.

Joseph died just one year too early to have a Miss. Death Certificate. The copy of the death certificate of Almira isn't very dark, I have had a copy of it made for you. T. J. Houston was the informant and the attending physician.

On Almira's death certificate her mother is Sina Brown, but on the 1850 census she's listed Sabrina which is probably right.

So far we have not been able to find Joseph Houston on any census. We've probably just missed it.

It looks like your wife and my husband are the same generation from Joseph and Almira.

There has got to be records somewhere, but where? If Joseph was left fatherless as a child he must have had some sort of inheritance from both his father and his grandfather most likely. Joseph evidently had something to be able to raise and educate 20 children. I wonder if the University of Memphis might have some record of who paid the bill for Dr. T. J. H. Could he have lived with some relatives? Maybe T. T's maternal grandparents lived there. It is all food for thought. Was there a City Directory for the years that he was in school there?

Do you know anything about the Hamrick's? When I sent the add into the HELPER I had only the death certificates to go by. The other names in the add are the Collins line and their birthplaces on the death certificates were wrong also.

Do you know anything about the Hamricks or the Brown's?

I have tried to find that list of the 17 children that Tex got but right now can't find it. Would you like me to send it when I do run across it?

We need to completely overhaul our notes and information. My husband refuses to write the letters but he loves to do the research, so I am "volunteered" to be the family scribe. We are trying to go as far back on all of our lines as we can.

We'd love to have any information that you have.

Thank you again for answering the add, when I get additional information I will send it to you.

(The second letter from that same person follows:)

Hi,

December 5, 1975

Was real glad to hear from you again and get all of the good information. Tex and I have thought for a long time that the Houston kin in Mississippi were hiding something. They have been too quick to discourage us. People always ask us if we are related to "Sam", we used to always say "no", but since we have been genealogy searching we have jokingly answered "only if it was illegitimate." We have wondered if our name was really Houston!

We have a small set of books (3 volumes) that deals with the illicit love affairs of the Royalty of the world. It was surprising to see the story of Houston in it. This story is also written differently from the others. According to the book THE RAVEN SAM HOUSTON by Marquis James (I am reading that now hoping to get some clue) Sam had plenty of female friends. This is a small town and our library has only a few books and does not have the book that you read. However, I could probably get it on a loan basis from Austin.

I am wondering if they are telling the truth about Joseph's birthplace and year of birth. It seems that they have gone to great lengths to hide whatever it is about Joseph. There must be some letters still existing or a diary or something somewhere.

When Joseph died there was a write-up in the paper and carried a picture of him with it. I do not have a copy of this but saw one years ago before we were interested in family tree.

We know where Sam was 21 Apr 1836. If Joseph was born in 1836 then we need to know the movements of Sam from about March of 1835 to March of 1836. Since reading the "The Raven" I am wondering if Joseph may not have been born earlier, maybe before his marriage to Allen, or maybe afterward while he was in Washington.

Last year we lived near Huntsville (about 30 miles). I wish I had known this then. If Sam was in Walker County when he transferred the land to Joseph then it should be in Texas records. It has been years since I have been to the Park where Sam's home is preserved but I did go to the museum in Huntsville last year.

I wish we knew the name of the man that Joseph was left with. Do you have access to the 1850 Walker County Texas census? I wonder if Joseph was there, especially if Sam's family was somewhere else. I have Byron Sistler's index to Tennessee for the Houston's. I didn't find Joseph in any Houston household but the index doesn't include Houston's that were in other households. I don't get to the genealogy libraries in Austin or Houston very often any more. Since Annie was under 10 years old in 1880 I have even tried Soundex for Joseph but didn't have any luck. I have never used the Archives section of the Texas State Library. If you have any suggestions or ideas for searching the Archives please let me know.

(Excerpts of third letter)

OKLAHOMA RECORDS

Volume X pg. 497 regarding the salt works on Grand River near (now) Salina: "Thos. L. ROGERS, a son of Captain John ROGERS and the brother of DIANA, the grandam wife of Sam Houston, located on Spavinaw Creek near Grand River in 1836 to raise stock....."

Vol. IX pp. 149, 150 speak of Diana ROGERS whose first husband was surnamed GENTRY, and she was later Diana HOUSTON. I believe these pages have to do with the power of attorney of which you wrote. For a copy of these pages, send \$1 and self addressed stamped envelope to me.

Finally I asked another person to go to the Collinsville area to see if he could get any information, and he got the same information from another descendant except he added more. He stated that Joseph Houston was brought to the Collinsville, Miss. area by Gen. Sam Houston and left with Thomas Hambrick of that area. (Clyde Walker, Rt. 1, Box 32, Collinsville, Ms.)

I think that the reason that Joseph was left with the Hambricks is that Thomas Hambrick's father, Capt. John Hambrick, served in the War of 1812 in a Georgia unit and was in the Battle of New Orleans and that his brother, Henry Hambrick, was one of the 13 men killed there, and Capt. John Hambrick became very close friends with General Jackson, and that General Houston asked General Jackson for help in placing this, I believe, his and Dianna Rogers son.

And Gen. Jackson, I imagine told him that his friend Capt. Hambrick, that was with him in the Battle of New Orleans and now was living at Collinsville, Mississippi, will take the boy.

So at Collinsville, Joseph was with good people, out of Tennessee, out of Oklahoma, and out of Texas, and as you know Gen. Houston's family exhumed Dianna's body and a marker that stated she was Sam Houston's wife was placed there.

An excerpt from a recent Texas correspondent follows, then my conclusion.

Dear Mr. Beeman:

In the school play I mentioned in my last letter I can only vaguely remember what it was all about. This was in 1933 and I was in the 7th grade in Webster, Texas. Our classroom teacher was a Miss Bracewell who considered herself an authority on Sam Houston. My class put on the play and I played the part of Sam. A little black haired girl named Kitty Kobayashi played my wife, Tiana (We pronounced it Ty-awn-ah). I wore an Indian blanket over my buckskins and part of the dialogue went something like this: "Ty-awn-uh I go hunt deer for supper, you take blanket, (removing blanket from

around my shoulders) put blanket over son so he no get cold, I go now." She then took the blanket and placed it over a crib containing a doll. This is where I got the idea that Sam and Tiana had a son. Miss Bracewell left this earth many moons ago so I can't ask her why she placed a son in the play. (Erwin R. Hillhouse, 1006 So. Lee, Alvin, Texas 77511

So in conclusion I wish to state that somewhere there is a record that will identify the Joseph Houston that Gen. Sam Houston left with the Thomas Hambrick at Collinsville, Lauderdale Co., Mississippi, and I'll be proud to have that record for my wife and children.

"SAM HOUSTON PASSPORT"

"I, the undersigned, Acting Secretary of War, do hereby request all the Tribes of Indians, whether in amity with the United States, or as yet not allied to them by Treaties, to permit safely and freely to pass through their respective Territories, -

--General Sam Houston--

a citizen of the United States, thirty-eight years of age, six feet two inches in stature, brown hair, and light complexion; and in case of need, to give him all lawful aid and protection.

"GIVEN UNDER my hand and the impression of the SEAL of the DEPARTMENT OF WAR, at the City of Washington, this Sixth day of August, in the Year of OUR LORD One Thousand eight hundred and thirty-two, and of the Independence of the UNITED STATES, the fifty seventh.

"(Signed) JOHN ROBB,

"Acting Secretary of War."

Armed with this passport, he came from Arkansas via Nacogdoches and San Felipe to San Antonio in December, 1832, where he had a conference with the Mexican authorities and with a delegation of Comanche Indians, who were sometimes roving residents of the States.

The Strickland Springs Cemetery is on the Gilmer Farm on an oiled road in the Southeast part of Harrison County, Texas. This cemetery has not been used for many years. Part of it was destroyed when a stock pond was built. The below listed stones are the only ones we could find. Hugh Strickland and members of his family are buried here, but the markers have long since disappeared. There was obviously once a fairly large cemetery about one acre in size. Not a single stone is left standing.

8. FAMILY FILES IN THE LIBRARY AT PA. HISTORICAL SOCIETY, PHILADELPHIA, PA.

One file contains the record of William Barnhill of York County, S.C. and since this record will be given in detail later, only the records dealing with Pennsylvania will be given.

Immigrants Robert and Sarah who settled in Bucks County, Pa., were parents of 6 and perhaps more children, but will give record of only 2; John and Samuel who married sisters.

John (2) (Robert (1) born 1729 in Ireland, married 1749 Sarah Craig who died 27 Feb. 1797, daughter of Daniel Craig.

Samuel ² (Robert ¹) born 1732 in Ireland married Jean sister to Sarah who married John his brother. He lived first at New Britain then Warrington Township, both in Bucks Co., Pa. He and family left the area, and possibly is the Samuel who was in Kentucky in the late 1700's.

Jean and Sarah Craig were daughters of Daniel of Warrington Twp.; see his will dated 26 July 1775 and probated 10 June 1776, Bucks Co., Pa. This will mentions his wife Margaret; sons Thomas, John and William; daughters Margaret (wife of James Barclay), Sarah (wife of John Barnhill); (She was also gr gr grandmother of Pres. Theodore Roosevelt); Jane (wife of Samuel Barnhill), Mary Lewis, and Rebecca (wife of Hugh Stephenson).

John ¹ (Robert ²) and Sarah Craig Barnhill were the parents of Robert and 2 daughters; Margaret who married Samuel Henry 22 Dec. 1770; Elizabeth who married Henry Toland 6 April 1780; and Robert ³ (John ² Robert ¹) married Elizabeth Potts.

12. BARNHILL/BARNWELL of S. CAROLINA AND ROOSEVELT OF NEW YORK AND PA. THROUGH TUSCORORA JOHN

This record states "John Barnwell was the progenitor of the Barnwell family who came to South Carolina from Dublin in 1701. John Barnhill, who died 27 Feb 1797 (married Sarah Craig) a descendant of Col. John Barnwell of S.C. who fought and captured the Tuscorora Indians 16 Nov 1711. His son Robert, born 31 Jan 1754, died 12 Aug 1814 and married Elizabeth Potts. Their daughter Margaret married Cornelius Van Achaack Roosevelt 9 Oct 1821."

I believe this genealogy is incorrect unless the imigrant Robert of Pennsylvania, whose son John married Sarah Craig, is the son of the John who went to S.C. in 1701. This is my own opinion -- Fern Airnsworth.

13. BARNHILL FAMILY OF ALAMANCE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

Robert, the progenitor of this family came from Northern Ireland in the 1760's to Newcastle, Delaware and later settled in Chester Co., Pa. In June 1776 he moved to Orange (Now Alamance) County, North Carolina. He entered claim for 400 acres on Quaker Creek, a branch of Haw River 11 Dec 1778. He entered other claims and in 1781 was taxed on 871 acres of land. His estate was probated August 1793 leaving wife Margaret (second wife) and children. His children were by the first wife, undoubtedly among others were:

James born 1756 in No. Ireland married Susan Harper 1788; died 25 Mar 1825 leaving property to widow and children, of which there were 10. His will probated Orange County, North Carolina 1825.

John born 1760 No. Ireland came with father Robert to Delaware then Chester County, Pa. and finally to Orange Co., North Carolina. He served in the N.C. Militia and lived there until 1803 when he moved to Henry Co., Georgia where he was living 1828.

The author of this series of Natchitoches Parish notes has other data relative to this Barnhill Family which she will share, if you write.

14. BARNHILL OF MONIFIETH PARISH SCOTLAND TO DELAWARE AND PITT CO., NORTH CAROLINA

David Barnhill born ca 1695 at BARNHILL in Monifieth Parish, Scotland came to the colonies ca 1731 receiving a survey 1734 in Kent County, Del. on Black Swamp Branch, Murderkill Hundred. He married Margaret Fleming, daughter of Robert and Aliss Fleming.

See will of Robert Fleming probated 11 Aug 1754 Kent Co., Del. Reg. of Wills Liber K Folio 94. Executor--David Barnhill. Wife Aliss; dau--Fillis, Margaret Barnhill dau of David; Martha and Hester daughters of George Fleming; Robert son of Aledander Fleming; David son of John Fleming; Elizabeth daughter of William Fleming; Hannah daughter of James Fleming Bro.-in-law David Barnhill; brothers and sisters not named.

David and Margaret Barnhill sold property in Kent Co., Del. 1762 and in that year records for this family appear in Pitt Co. North Carolina. They were the parents of at least 5 children all born in Del., but moved to Pitt Co., N.C. by 1762 where they married and died in the same county. Later descendants are to be found in Horry Co., S.C.

Marched to Lincoln Courthouse North Carolina and joined under General Sumpter. After this term returned to York in S.C. Volunteered again in August 1780 under Gen. Sumpter at Camden, and was in their defeat at the mouth of Fishing Creek, S.C. He then returned to York District and they marched under Feteague ? thru that part of the country for the Toreys were very troublesome. Amendment filed in Hall Co., Ga. stating he was born Bucks Co., Pa. 1 Dec 1760, living in York District, S.C. when in service, 30 years in Franklin Co., Ga. and the last 10 years in Hall Co. Ga.
