## REPORT ON THE SUMMER WORK SHOP

The summer workshop was held in the Genealogy Room of the Shreve Memorial Library on August 11 and 12<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. James Huddleston, president (and founder) of the Mesquite Genealogy Society in the suburban area of Dallas, Texas, was the speaker. Adjacent to the Pilgrim cemetery stands the Pilgrim Predestinarian Regular Baptist Church organized in Crawford County, Illinois July 26, 1833 by Daniel Parker. The members moved to Texas in a body. They arrived November 12, 1835.

The first recorded meeting in Texas was held in Austin's Colony year the present town of Anderson, Grimes County, on January 20, 1834. This first meeting was held in the home of Daniel Parker, July 4, 1835.

The log church built here in December 1848 was the first church built. The present building is the fourth on this same site. There has been continuing worship on the site since 1833. Daniel Parker was the first pastor. He held this position from 1833 to 1844.

There is a small replica of the original church which was built in 1848. It is furnished with hewn log pews and furniture as was in the old church. This furniture is in miniature.

X Mrs. Elizabeth (Scott) Wilburn, Route Three, box 239A, Texarkana, Texas, 75501: writes : John Martin, born about 1795 in Ga., died in Bienville Parish, La. between 1860 and 1865, I think. Who was his wife, and when did she die? They were in the Republic of Texas in 1829, when a daughter, Nancy was born; and in Arkansas in 1831, when another daughter, Leanna (my great-great grandmother) was born. The family was on the 1840 census of Claiborn Parish, La., but by 1850, the wife of John is not listed on the census of Bienville Parish. Was John's middle initial "N", and if so, what did it stand for? I surely would like to hear from any descendants, or any person who can tell me more about this family. The two daughters mentioned above, married into the Evans (Evens) and Johnston families.

I would also like to present to your library, this history of my husband's family which I have just written and had published. Thank you.

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
