**Table of Contents**

**And**

**Surname Index**

Starting in 1978, The Genie contained a Table of Contents and a Surname Index at the back. However, in an effort to be consistent with the previous years, it was decided that we would place an Index with each year.

1. Each separate Index contains all 4 quarters for that year. The Table of Contents is first and the Surname Index is second.
2. Note that every page contains a red header that has the “Year, Volume, and Number.” You can use this as a guide to determine which volume and number you want to look at.
3. You can search the Index for a name and it will search all four quarters. You will have to click “next” (or the forward button next to “search”) to see subsequent searches for that year).
4. We found that some of the letters are very faint, some are hole-punched, and some have typed over corrections as well as blemishes or blotches. So the search function does always work as expected. You might try searching for just part of a name (first or last part) OR you can just browse the index. **BUT remember if you choose to browse, you will need to browse each of the four quarters.** Even if you have to browse the index, we thought this might be easier than searching or browsing each individual volume.
